

Application	To fit in with the calendar, we recommend that you apply for exchange
	between June 17 and August 30, 2024.
Admission	An admissions decision will be determined 4-6 weeks after the
Notification	application closes. Students will receive the admission result via e-mail.

### **Application Materials Required**

- 1. CV
- 2. Transcript
- 3. Official Enrollment Certificate from UChicago
- 4. Statement of your research interest and experience (1 page)
- 5. Recommendation letter from your advisor or the department chair
- 6. Invitation letter from the faculty member at the NCKU (if applicable)
- 7. A head-shot photo (jpg format) for NCKU student ID
- 8. A copy of your passport bio page

### **Health Insurance**

Private	All exchange students need to purchase their own overseas insurance, which

	be certified by our Bureau of Consular Affairs (BOCA) to be accepted at the
	registration of NCKU. Non-R.O.C. nationals not enrolled in the NHI program
	should pay their medical expenses during their isolation period if they are
	diagnosed with COVID-19 in Taiwan. ( <u>Taiwan CDC</u> )

#### Visa

- Please be advised not to enter t he country with a landing visa (in extensible), whose
   90 days' period will not cover one semester.
- 2. Students will be responsible for all visa-related fees.

#### Short-Term Research Visa

After your admission is confirmed, we will send a letter to the Ministry of Education to review your short-term research plan. Then you can apply for a **Visitor Visa** from the <u>Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in Chicago</u> with the reply letter from the Ministry of Education (the code for visa is "研習-FR").

Required documents below:

- Official Letter (provided by host professor by using e-document system)
- 2. <u>Application Form</u> (Chinese version only)
- 3. Copy of Student's Passport
- 4. Certificate of Enrollment in Home University
- 5. Invitation Letter or a Certificate of Collaborative Research

# **Cost of Study and Living Estimates**

Tuition Fees	Once you obtain the offer from the PI, your tuition, fees and on-
Cost of Housing	campus housing will be waived or compensated.  *If the on-campus dormitories are full, we will provide you with a monthly subsidy of NT\$10,000, and introduce you to off-campus dormitories.
Living Cost	Meals and other living expenses may range from NT\$6,000 to NT\$10,000 per month, depending on individual lifestyles.
